**Introduction**

This document describes the amendments and enhancements that have been made to the software to cater for the introduction of ScotMoves. A video guide as to how to setup and use Cattledata in conjunction with ScotMoves is available from <https://youtu.be/t-88C3L8bVQ>

**Content**

**1. Maintenance Routines**

- a. In Location Codes, you can now categorise a Location as an Additional Holding.

**2. ScotEID**

- a. The settings in ScotEID Parameters that were for the Beef Efficiency Scheme now also apply to ScotMoves.
- b. ScotEID Births, Movements and Weighings have been renamed BES Births, Registrations and Weighings.
- c. Three new options have been added – ScotMoves Allocations, ScotMoves Movements and ScotMoves Audit.

These operate in a very similar way to the BCMS options, and should be used in conjunction with them as indicated below.

<b>Scenario</b>	<b>BCMS</b>	<b>ScotMoves</b>
Purchase from a Market – animal moves to your Main Holding.	Yes (Movement)	No
Purchase from a Mart – animal moves direct to an Additional Holding.	Yes (Movement)	Yes (Allocation)
Animal moves from your Main Holding to an Additional Holding	No	Yes (Movement)
Animal moves between Additional Holdings	No	Yes (Movement)
Animal moves from an Additional Holding to your Main Holding	No	Yes (Movement)
Animal moves from an Additional Holding to a Market	Yes (Movement)	No
Animal is born on an Additional Holding	Yes (Registration)	Yes (Allocation)

## **Installation**

1. If you are not already running Version 14.000, you will need a new Activation Key from us. This can be requested by emailing [support@farmdata.co.uk](mailto:support@farmdata.co.uk).
2. Ensure that you have an up-to-date backup of Cattedata.
3. From within Cattedata choose 'Help' -> 'Download Latest Update'.
4. Press 'Next' to proceed and 'Start' to bring down and install the Update.
5. After installation, you should check that you are running Version 14.000 ('Help' -> 'About Cattedata' will confirm).
6. Process Complete.
