

Introduction

This document describes the amendments and enhancements that have been made to the software.

Content

1. Calvings

- a. For animals that have had a Service recorded as an Embryo Transfer, the Donor Cow is now shown on the screen. If a Donor Cow is chosen, then she will be recorded as being the Genetic Dam with the animal that actually produced the calf as the Surrogate Dam.

2. BCMS

- a. The Registration option has been amended so as to allow calves born from Embryo Transfers to be Registered. In the case where the Genetic Dam is imported and does not have a valid 'UK' official tag, then the Genetic Dam will be taken to be the Surrogate Dam.

3. BES

- a. The recording of Births has also been amended as per 2a.

4. Mobile Edition

- a. For calvings the list of dams has been replaced with a drop-down box which will show more entries, and a Find option has been added. Also, the Sex, Vigour and Size of the calves born is no longer pre-selected.
- b. In EID Scanning, the Ear Number and Official Tag of animals scanned is now shown.

Installation

1. If you are not already running Version 14.xxx, you will need a new Activation Key from us. This can be requested by emailing support@farmdata.co.uk.
2. Ensure that you have an up-to-date backup of Cattledata.
3. From within Cattledata choose 'Help' -> 'Download Latest Update'.
4. Press 'Next' to proceed and 'Start' to bring down and install the Update.
5. After installation, you should check that you are running Version 14.008 or higher ('Help' -> 'About Cattledata' will confirm).
6. Process Complete.
