Introduction

This document describes the amendments and enhancements that have been made to the software.

Content

1. BCMS

- a. We have been contacted by BCMS as they have noticed that some Death Submissions are not going through their system correctly, and they have to manually put them in. A change to the namespace in the header of the submission being transmitted has been required.
- b. When doing an Audit with BCMS you can now exclude the checking of 'Dams' Tags.

2. Occurrences

- a. The Occurrences of 'Archive' and 'External Transfer' now only show if you have more than one Business on the system.
- b. When scanning in Purchases, the check for duplicates routine always accepted the first animal regardless of whether it was a duplicate or not.

3. Reports

- a. For the Census and Valuation you can now modify under 'Limits' the Age Bands used for Calves. This can be useful for completing returns when different Bands are required. The current default values are:-

- Under 6 Months
- 6 to 12 Months
- 12 to 24 Months
- Over 24 Months

- b. What appears on the Start-up Report is now configurable.

These settings can be changed under 'Maintenance Routines' -> 'Startup Checks'

Installation

1. Ensure that you have an up-to-date backup of Dairydata.
2. If you have not already done so install Version 7 as per the letter you were sent in Oct 2012.
3. From within Dairydata choose 'Help' -> 'Download Latest Update'.
4. Press 'Next' to proceed and 'Start' to bring down and install the Update.
5. The password for the update is the word 'beef' in lowercase.
6. This update requires the .NET 4.0 Framework so it will download this (if it is not already present on your computer) before it goes onto the normal installation screen.
7. After installation you should check that you are running Version 7.009 ('Help' -> 'About Dairydata' will confirm).
8. Process Complete.
