

Dairydata Software Release Notice 6

October 2012

Introduction

In this release of the software we have taken the opportunity to move it into the latest version of the programming language and report writing software.

This update is **only suitable** for Windows XP, Vista & Windows 7 machines.

Content

1. Animal Records

- a. If you amend a Health Treatment it now updates the Pharmacy.

2. Animal Occurrences

- a. You can now enter the Birth Weight of a Calf when you do a Calving.
- b. In Health Treatments the Duration that a Treatment lasts has been added.
- c. For Cull/Casualty and Sales you can now specify the Haulier and Vehicle Number.
- d. The Registration & Premium Occurrences have been removed. You can now record your Registrations & Beef Calf Claims (if applicable) in the BCMS section.

3. BCMS

- a. The option to notify the Death of an animal to BCMS has been added.
- b. The webservices application has been incorporated into the software so you no longer need to install it in order to notify information to BCMS.

4. Maintenance Routines

- a. The option to setup what is known as a Health Plan has been added. This can be useful for those who buy in cattle, and vaccinate them on arrival. Drugs and Quantities can be preset and they are automatically applied when an animal is Purchased.

5. Reporting

- a. A Drugs in Pharmacy report has been added.
- b. The Date Last Weighed has been added to Selective Reporting.

6. Electronic Identification

- a. For those of you who are interested in this, the software now supports the following readers:-

Agrident AWR100 (this is a simple stick reader)

Agrident APR500 (this is a more advance reader which you can log events on)

Royal Tag I-Read (this is a simple stick reader)

As well as the existing Tagmaster Anilog 3060

We've done quite a bit of work on incorporating the APR 500 into the software, and it allows you to record your standard occurrences (calving, health, etc.) on it before coming back into the office and uploading the information into your records.

7. Mobile Edition

- a. There is now also a version which will run on an IPAQ or similar device which has Windows Mobile 4, 5, 6 or 6.5 on it.
- b. It will also run on a PSION Walkabout Pro, which when attached with an AIR 200 scanner can provide an alternative form of Electronic Tag Reader but with access to an Animals Record.
